Be familiar with the following outlines and Scriptures so that you can, without hesitation, step forward to counsel those that come forward during the invitation.

Always begin each counseling session by making certain of the inquirer's salvation. Do not take this for granted. Be sure that he/she can give a clear salvation testimony before dealing with them on other topics.

Please list the following outlines in your Bible for ready reference.

Romans Road

1. **Fact of sin:** A person must realize he is a sinner before he/she can be saved. Romans 3:23, 3:10
2. **Penalty for sin:** Death is the only price for sin. Romans 6:23, Romans 5:12
3. **Penalty paid by Christ:** Romans 5:8
4. **Salvation:** Have the person pray the sinner's prayer, offering help if needed. Remember, this may be the first time this person as ever prayed. Romans 10:9-10,13
5. **Assurance:** Never leave a person until they know they are saved and that they are basing their salvation on the Bible, not emotions etc. Romans 10:13, I John 5:13

Christians out of Fellowship

1. **Confession** of sin to the Lord: I John 1:9
2. **Separation** from the World: Phil 4:8, I Cor. 10:31
3. **Assurance:** I John 5:13

Four Steps to Victory

1. **Pray:** Prayer is from the heart not the lips
2. **Daily Bible Reading:** Suggest beginning in John, then read I, II, III John, then read the entire New Testament
3. **Witness:** The first thing a new convert should do once they have left the altar is tell someone of their salvation.
4. **Obey the Word:** Obedience regarding baptism, church membership, stewardship, attendance, etc.
